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Kia ora Parents, Caregivers and Whānau,

It has been a busy week for a variety of reasons as we head towards the end of term two.

Our Kaiako have been busy completing learning check ins with our learners in preparation for our mid year reporting and learning conversations. The purpose of these learning conversations, are to actively involve both parent and learner in a conversation that provides evidence of learning progress and ways that both parents and teachers can assist the learner to accelerate their learning progress. Research indicates, that if there is a positive partnership between learners, parent and teacher, then learning is valued by all involved and progress continues and accelerates. The majority of our learning check ins are complete and the data that has been collected has gone through a moderation process to ensure consistency and to implement the next steps in your child's learning. Mid year reports are being compiled and will be ready to send home in week nine for you to look at and share with your child, in preparation for their learning conversations. Our report format has changed and is designed to provide you and your child / children with a snapshot of where they are with their learning progress, at this current point in their learning journey. The information in these reports is to provide you with an opportunity to discuss their current learning and promote further thinking around their learning goals and how they can continue to make progress towards these, to achieve these in the timeframes that they have given themselves. This will also provide our children with the knowledge and information they require, to be an active participant in their learning conversations with whānau and their Kaiako. Bookings for these conversations will be available through our Skool Loop app and will run across three afternoons in week ten, Tuesday 2nd July - Thursday 4th July starting at 3pm. Bookings will go live on Monday to give whānau plenty of time to get organised to attend these. We look forwards to seeing you all in week ten, to celebrate the learning that has occurred for your child / children, after the completion of the first half of the school year.

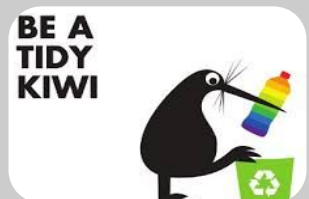
INDIE

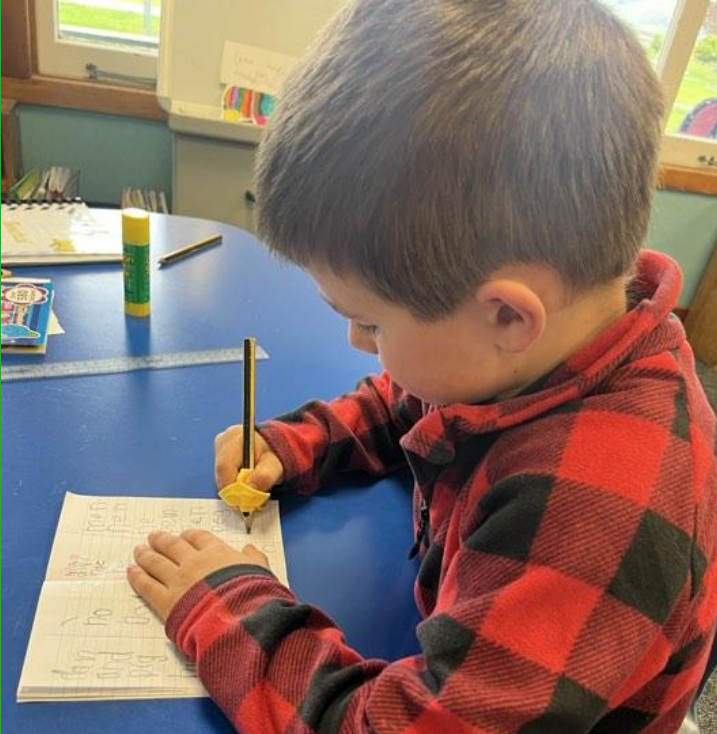
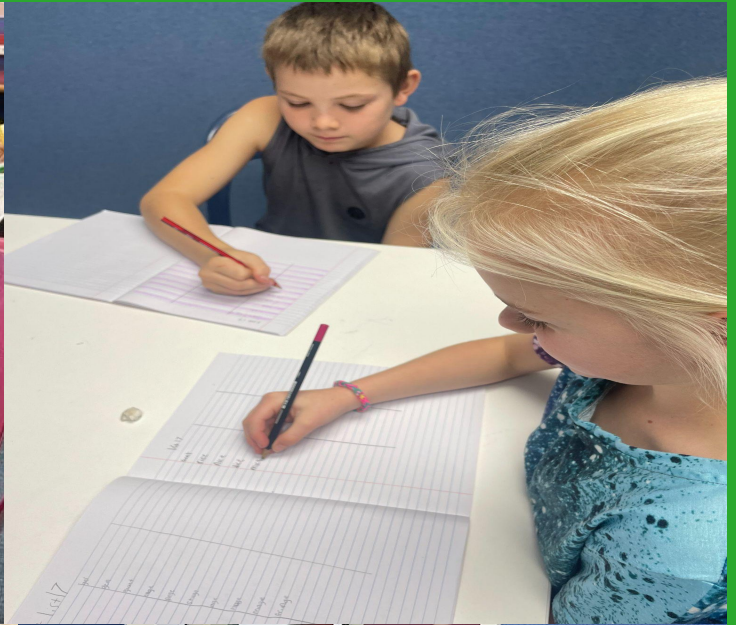
Kaiaponi Farms

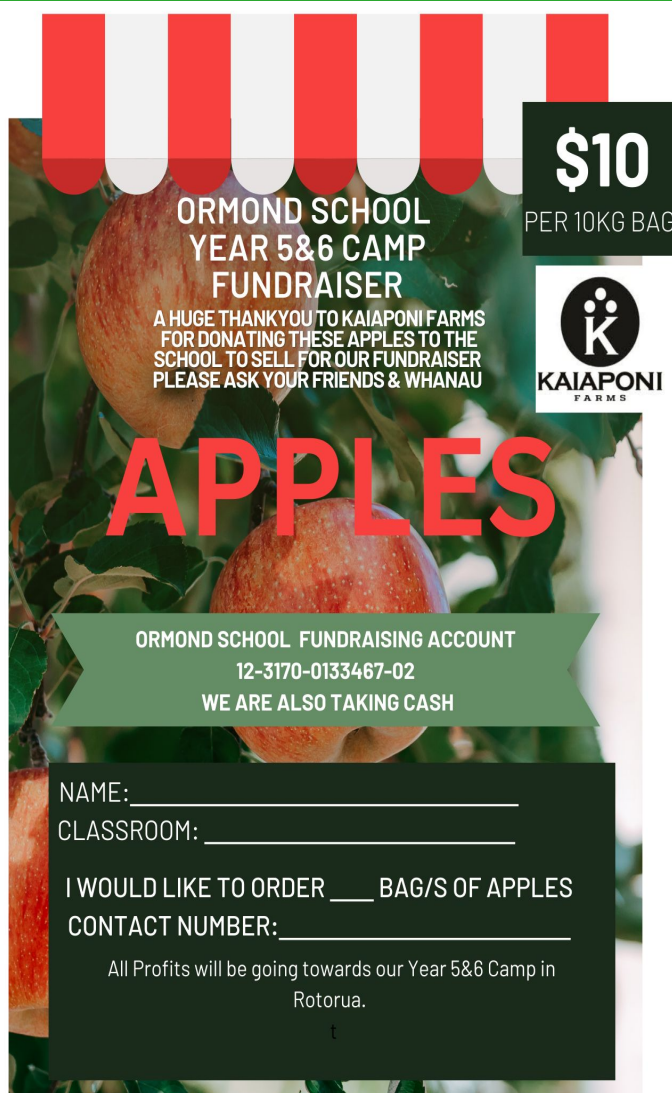
