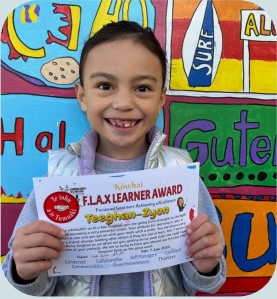

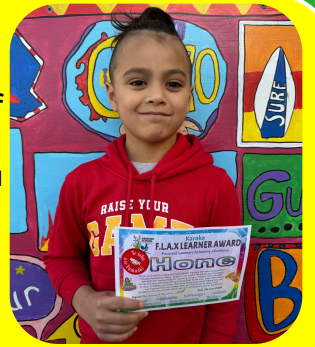
TEEGHAN

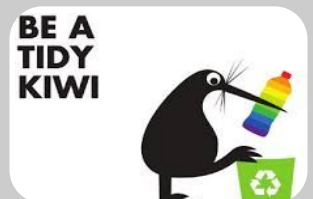
CARMEN

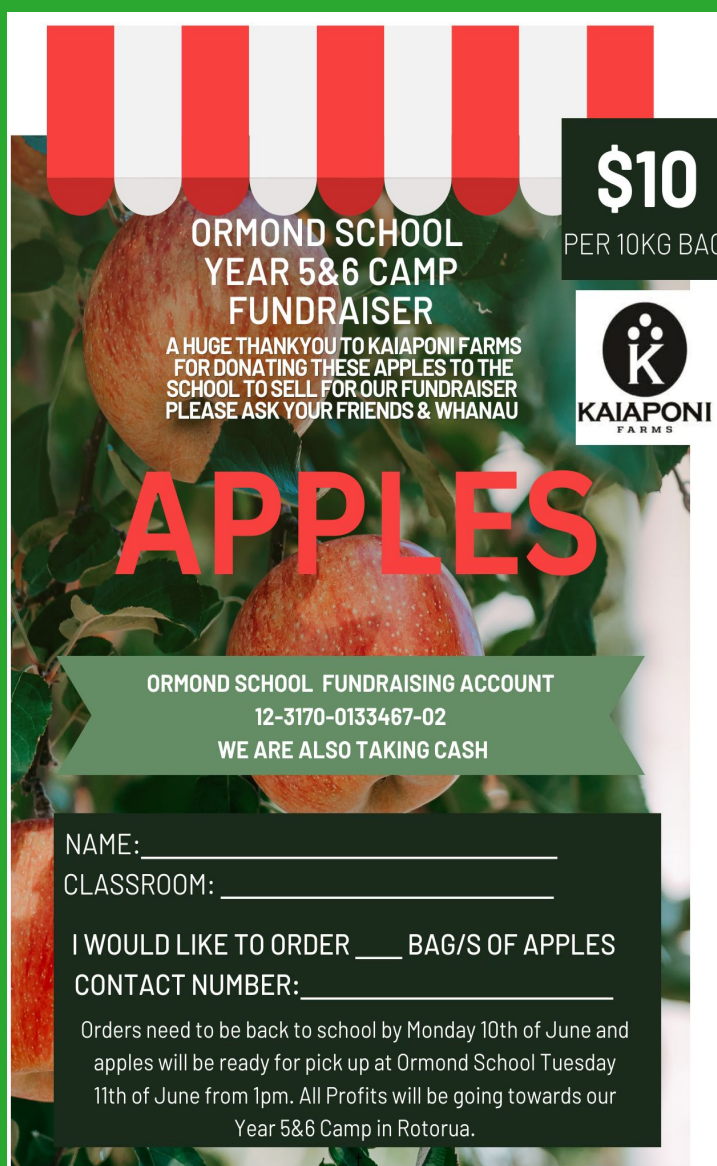
